

Disclosure of facts

A person applying for or receiving benefit payments must

1. state all facts which are relevant to the benefit and, on request by the Sozialamt (social services authority) concerned, permit third parties to provide the necessary information;
2. notify the authorities without delay of changes in the situation which substantially affect the payment of benefits or for which declarations have been made in connection with benefits (e.g. new job, payment of a child allowance or rent subsidy, ownership of a car);
3. designate proof and, on request on request by the Sozialamt concerned, submit this or agree to its submission to the Sozialamt.
